1. a pass in University Entrance English, or
2. a Pass in Sixth Form Certificate English with minimum achievement of Level 5; or
3. an achieved in NCEA Level 2 English, or
4. a piece of written work set by the Aperfield Montessori Trust.

If you are unable to submit a copy of the certificate, or if you have not passed the required English qualification as listed, we would like you to submit the following written work.

1. In your own handwriting write a formal letter telling the Assessor something of yourself and your life.
2. In your own handwriting write a short essay (approximately 500 words) on what you like about Montessori Education, and how you think this course would be of benefit to you.

In presenting the short essay for your eligibility exercise, please follow these instructions:

- Preferably use A4 paper
- Leave a margin approximately 4cm on the left hand side of the page
- Number the pages on the right hand side of the top line of each page
- Use double spacing and leave a line between each paragraph
